Course Workload	International students generally take a course load equalling 30 ECTS credits per semester.				
Grading System	In addition to the final examination, classes are assessed continuously (participation, small projects, papers, etc.). Field projects require written reports sometimes accompanied by an oral exam. All courses are graded on a scale of 0 to 20. The minimum pass mark is 10/20.				
Accommodations	On-campus & Off-campus housing is available. Prices can vary between €300 and €600 per month for private accommodation for one person depending on the size, the services provided and the duration of the exchange. Students staying in residences need to pay each semester in advance.				
Living Costs	Students should expect to spend around €750 per month for living expenses (housing included).				
Visa to France					
Health Insurance	Non-European Students under 28 years of age and staying in France in excess of 90 days: upon arrival in France need to subscribe to (with the help of NEOMA's international office) the French National Student Social Security Scheme (2015/16 fee: €215). Students will also need a private insurance policy covering health care, repatriation, etc. Finally, any accommodation in France must be covered by Housing insurance. The cost is a one-time fee between €25 and €65.
