

## Testing and Self-Isolation Requirements for those with COVID-19 Infection

## Nova Scotia:

- Students in placements in Nova Scotia Health, and IWK facilities will continue to follow self-isolation guidelines of those institutions.
  - 1. Nova Scotia Health Nova Scotia Health COVID-19 Status or Reason for Work Absence
  - 2. Please note that students do not need to enter a name or ID number using the employee/physician lookup tool to use this form. Select your COVID status and further instructions will appear in the dropdown menu.
- If you are rotating at the IWK, please also call IWK OHSW at (902) 221-8900 as it is a separate health authority and currently, the guidance for return to clinical work varies from the NSH.
- All medical students must inform the Office of Student Affairs of any positive test and are asked to send a copy of the rapid and/or PCR test result.
- Pre-clerkship and Clerkship students must follow their <u>respective leave processes</u>.

## New Brunswick:

- Faculty, students, and staff conducting work in Horizon Health facilities will continue to follow immunization, testing, reporting and self-isolation guidelines from Horizon Health as noted in the link below.

- All others working on UNB campus are to follow the <u>UNB quidelines</u>.
- Pre-clerkship and Clerkship students must follow their respective leave processes.
