## SHARING SUCCESS TO PROMOTE INNOVATION IN HIV AND HEPATITIS C (HCV) PREVENTION: YOUTH, NON-URBAN SETTINGS, AND NOVEL STRATEGIES.

This webinar series will explore the need for innovation in HIV and HCV prevention, particularly in non-urban settings across Canada. The content for this series is drawn from a Nova Scotia Health Research Foundation (NSHRF) funded study of youth-oriented HIV and HCV prevention, as well as from two parallel CIHR funded projects:

Mobilizing Information, Preventing Infection (MIPI) is a CIHR dissemination grant intended to facilitate dissemination of key findings from the three-year NSHRF-funded study "Our Youth, Our Response" (OYOR). OYOR looked at the programmatic and policy responses aimed at youth-oriented HIV and HCV prevention in Atlantic Canada.

Community Preparedness in the Context of HIV POCT is a one-year CIHR Catalyst Grant which seeks to determine what is needed to initiate HIV point of care testing (POCT) in communities throughout Atlantic Canada. This has involved a series of ongoing consultations involving HIV prevention experts from Nova Scotia, Newfoundland and Labrador, New Brunswick, and Prince Edward Island.
