# IDENTITY

- **Identity**

**=> the conception and expression of a person's individuality**

**Two dimensions:**

- 1) personal**
- 2) collective**



# COLLECTIVE IDENTITY

- **Collective identity**

**the idea that a group of people accept a fundamental and consequential similarity that causes them to feel solidarity amongst themselves (Brubaker and Cooper, 2000).**

**Similarities in collective identity:**

- **Language**
- **Religion**
- **Ethnicity**
- **common formative experience**

**=> shared 'culture'**



# IDENTITY AND NATIONALISM

- **Nationalism**
  - ⇒ ideology that emphasises shared culture to build a cross-class alliance around a nation-building project
- **Nationalism and identity**
  - Nationalism ⇒ Since 19<sup>th</sup> century the most popular form of collective ID
- **Types of nationalism**
  - Ethnic
  - Civic



# IDENTITY AND EUROPE

- **European experience with nationalism**  
=> **mostly negative**
- **'European' identity**  
=> **as alternative to national**  
=> **mostly civic conception**
- **But:**
  - **contested**
  - **nested (regional, national, subnational)**
  - **European = EU?**

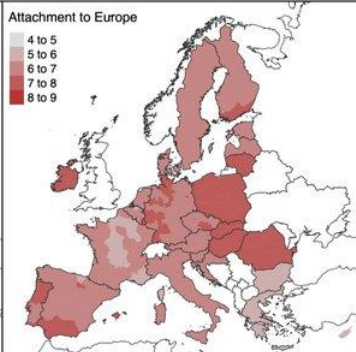
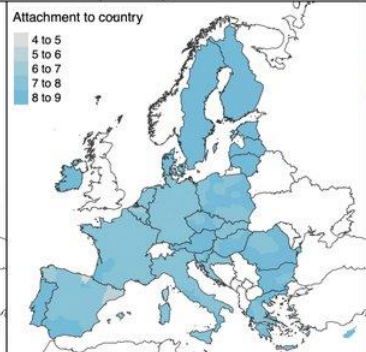

# What do Europeans feel most attached to?

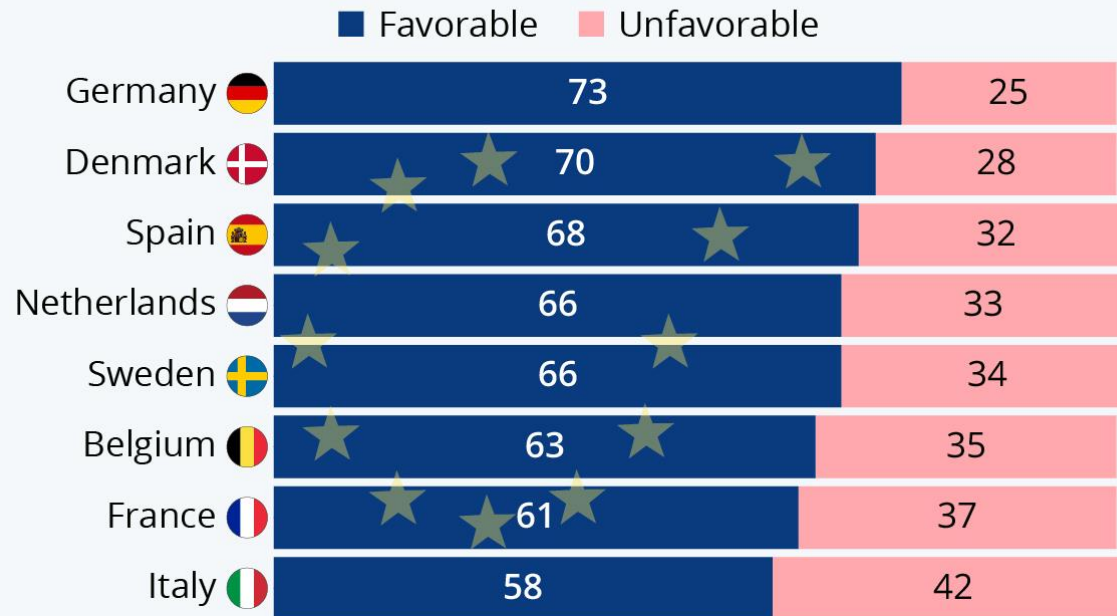
Average values from the answers to three questions from the 2021 European Quality of Government Index.

Share of respondents with the following views on the EU by country (in percent)



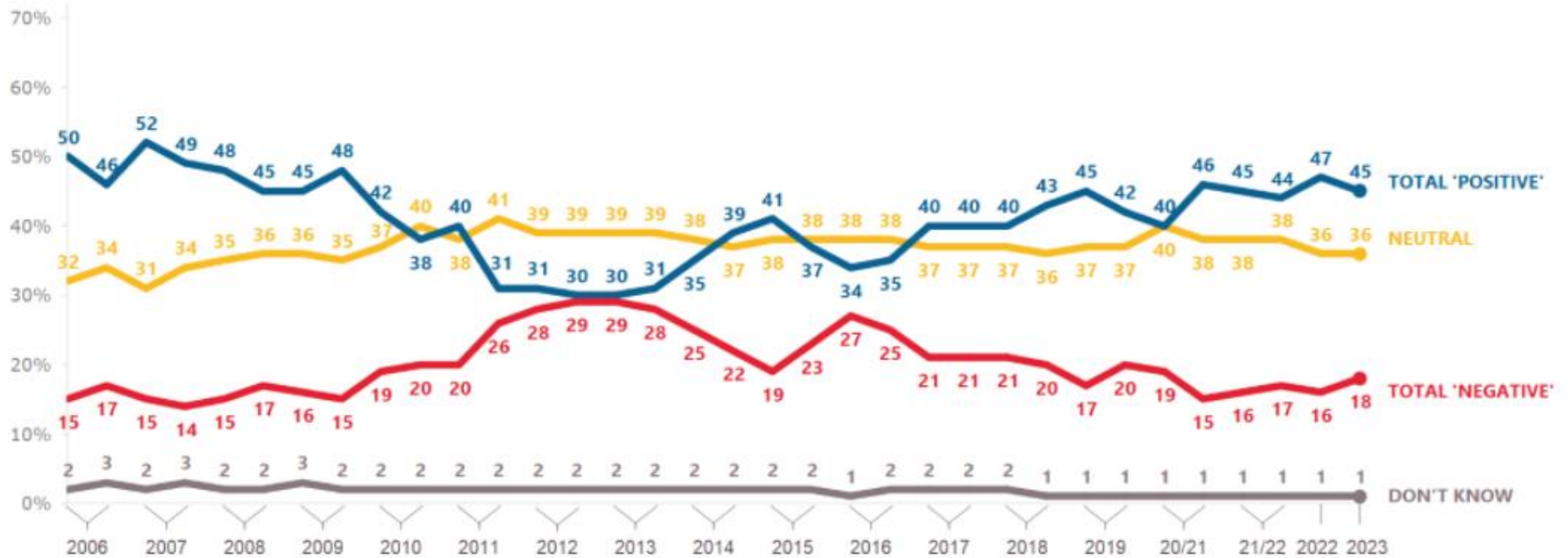

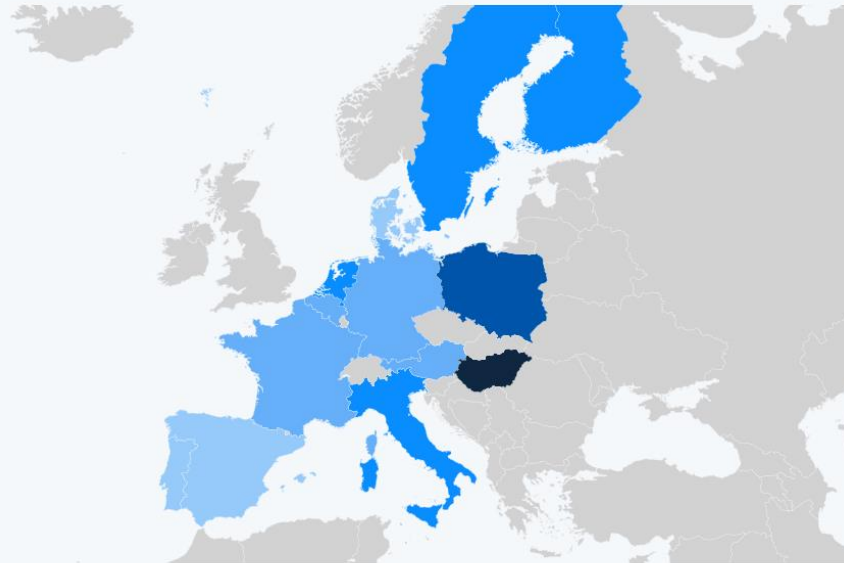

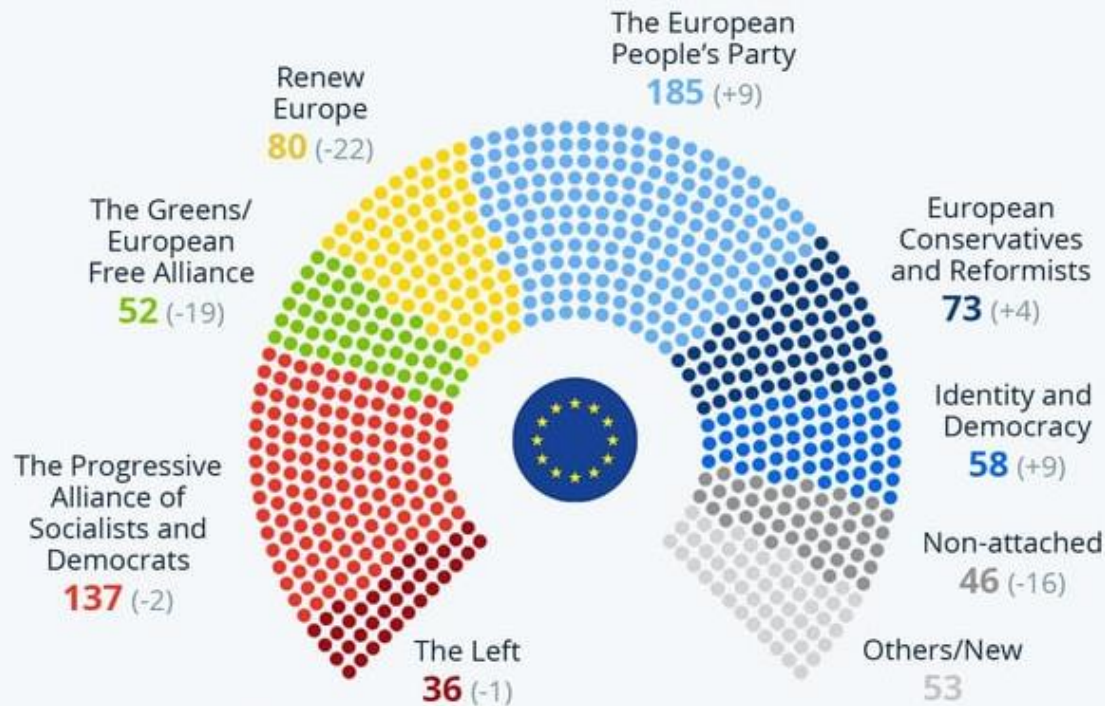

# 2024 EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT ELECTIONS: A RIGHT TURN?

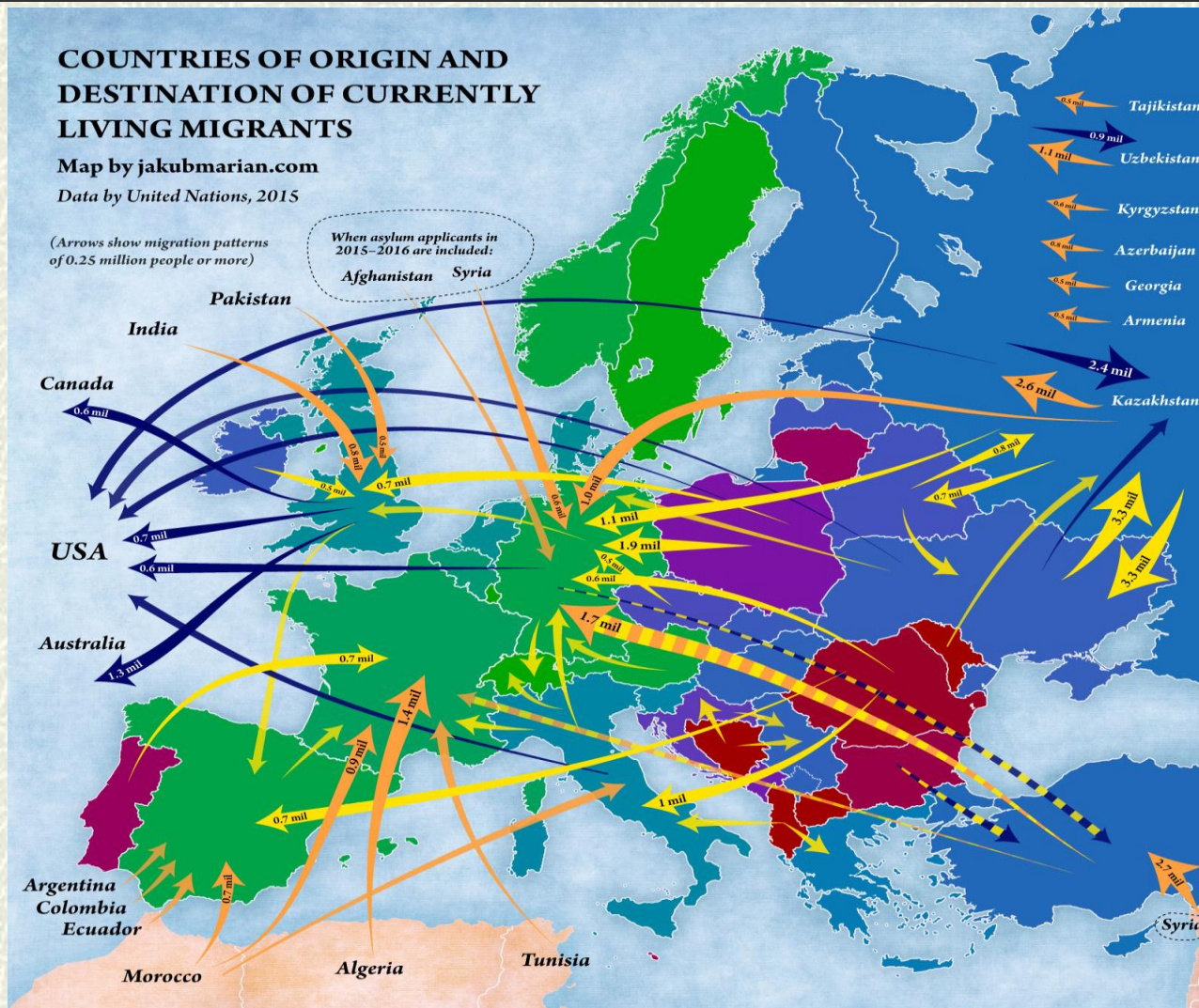

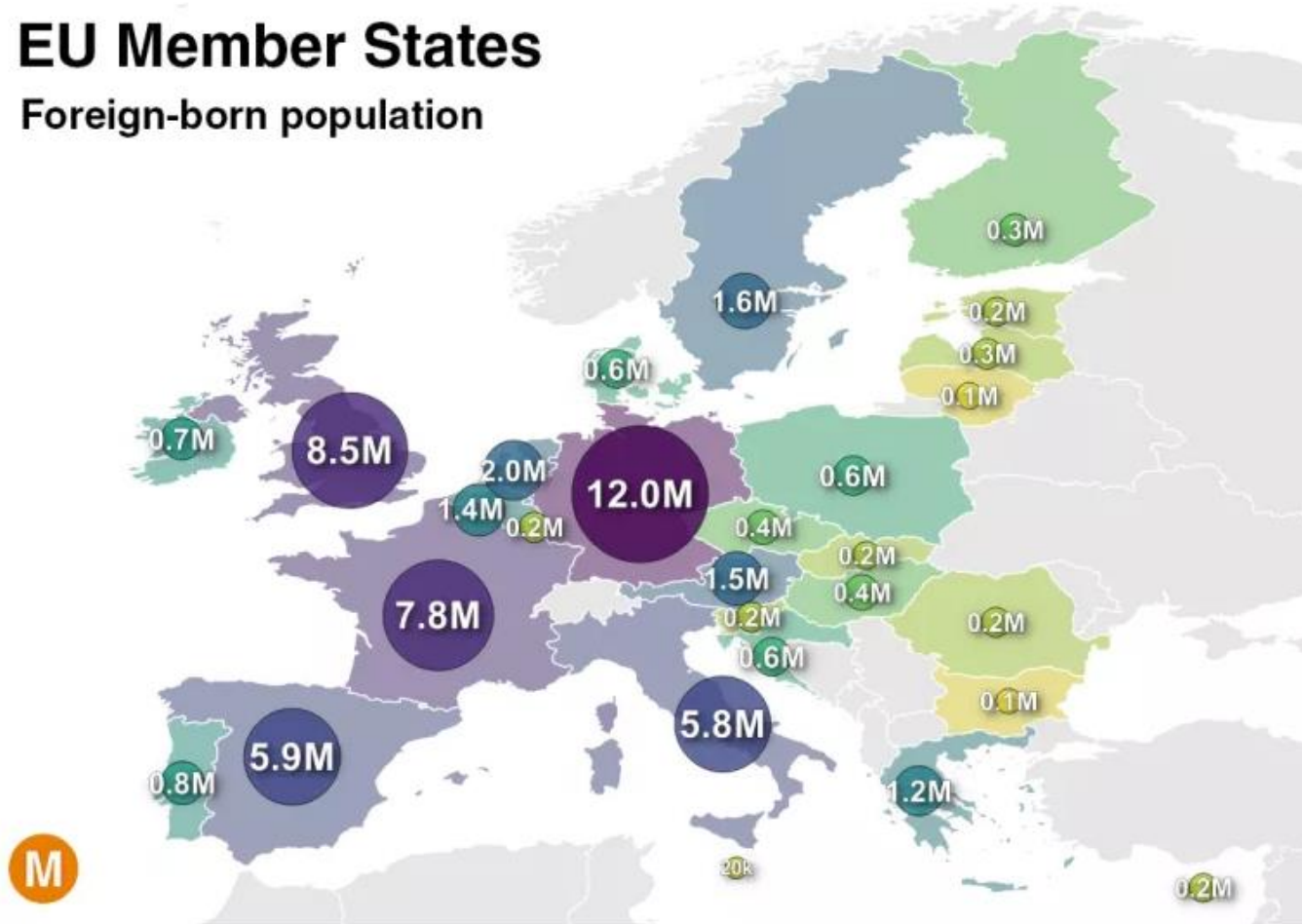

## EU Member States Foreign-born population

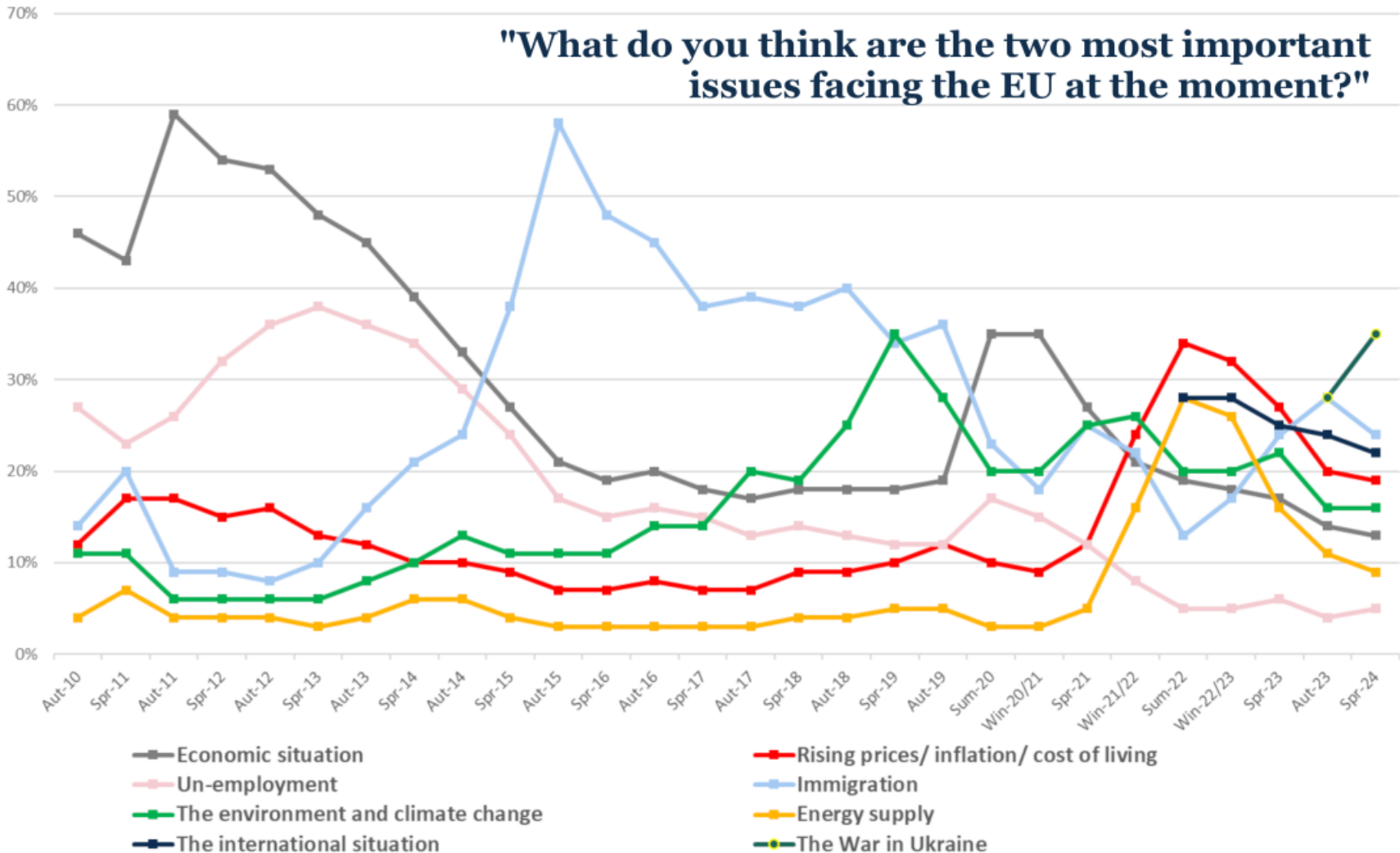

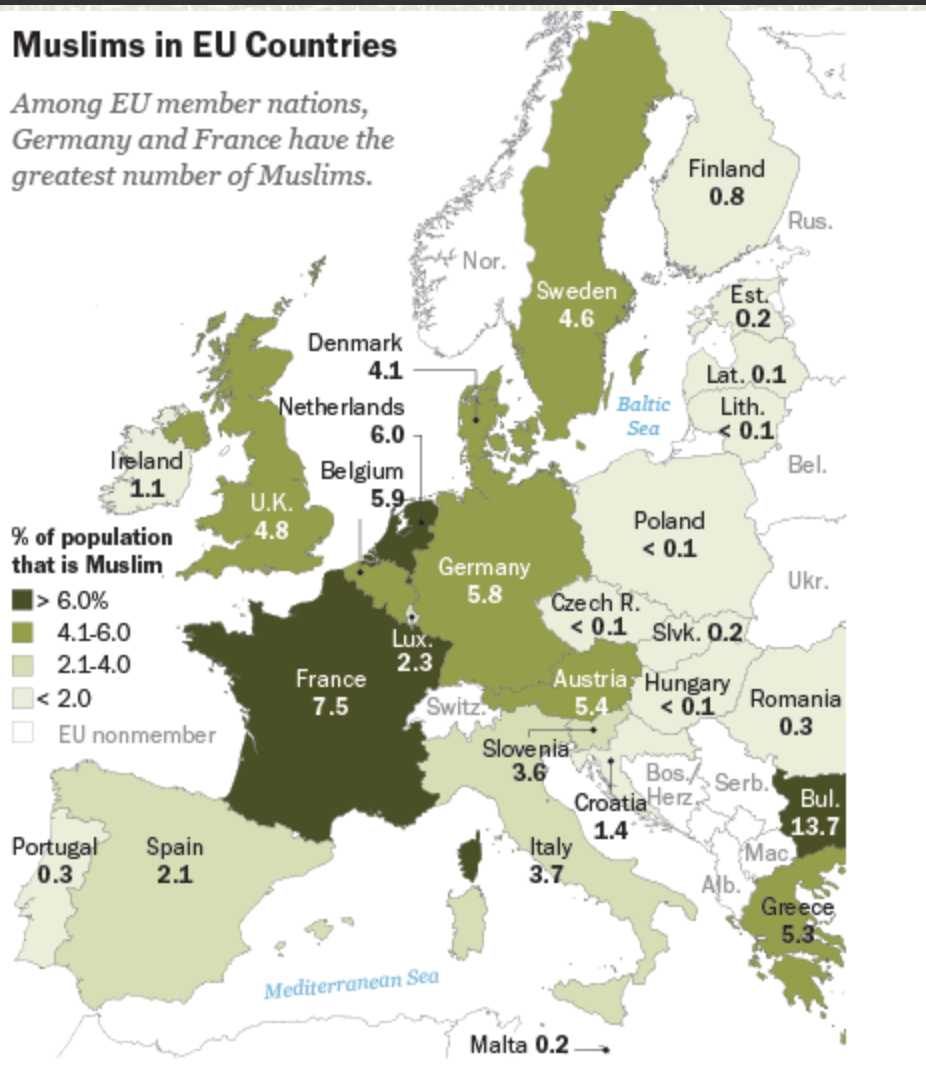

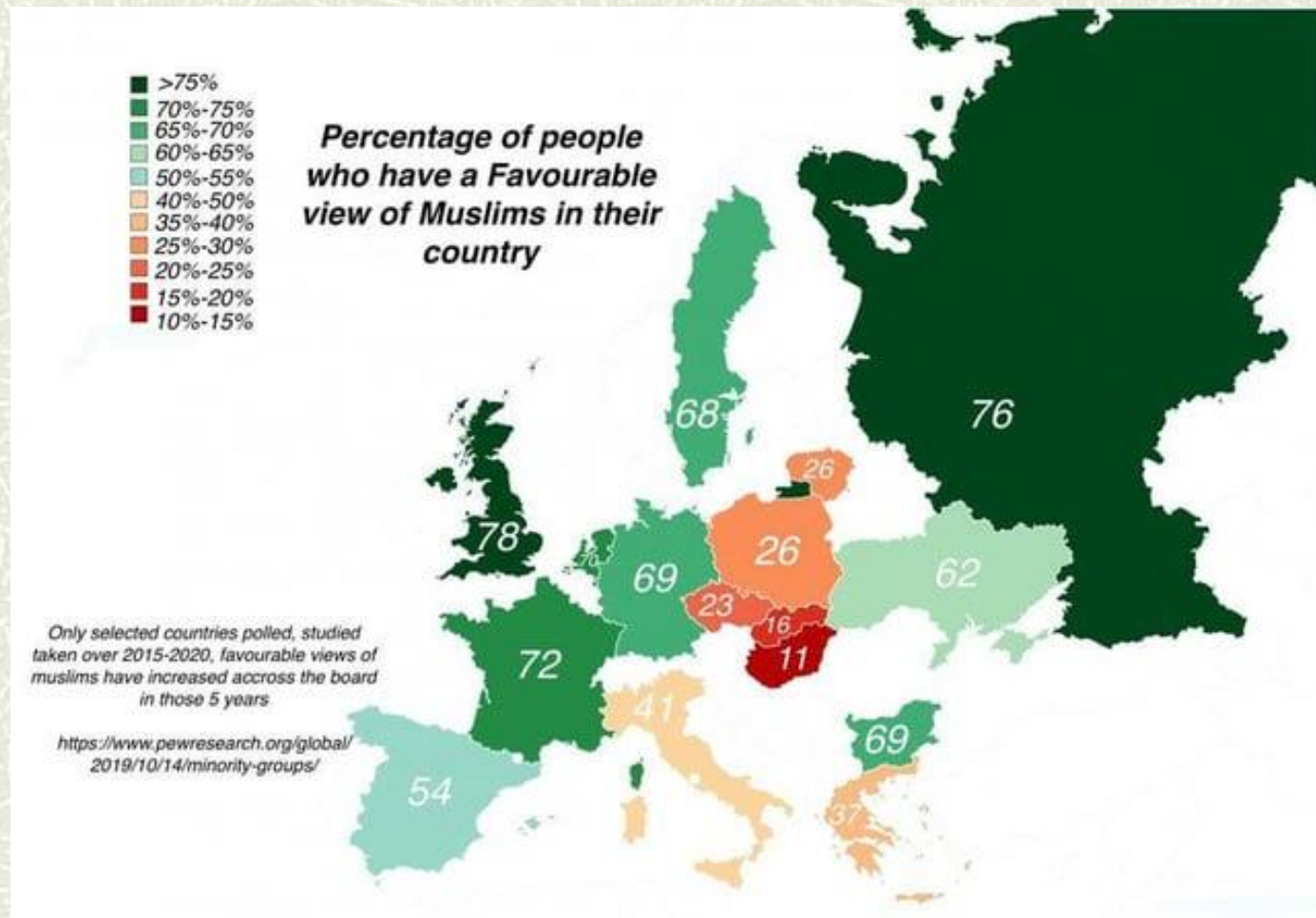
