



JEAN MONNET EUROPEAN UNION CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE ESSAY AWARD

The Jean Monnet European Union Centre of Excellence (JMEUCE) at Dalhousie University is funded in part by the European Union (EU) to study comparative policies pertaining to the EU and Canada, EU-Canada relations and EU policies more generally.

The Centre has established an annual award of \$250 for the best student essay on any aspect of the EU. Students are encouraged to examine topics that deal with individual member states or the Union as a whole.

Eligibility

The JMEUCE Essay Award is open to all registered full-time or part-time (minimum of three courses) Dalhousie University students who are presently enrolled in a graduate programme or undergraduate study. **Papers must be between 4,000 and 5,000 words in length, and be submitted in both electronic form and hard copy** following the standards of the APA style guide in 12 point font, double spaced.

Application and deadline

Candidates are to submit a copy of their essay in electronic form to jmeuce@dal.ca and a hard copy accompanied by a letter of recommendation from a faculty member by **3.00 pm on 25th April 2017**. Hard copies must be submitted to the JMEUCE in Room 339 of the Henry Hicks Building.

Selection Committee

The Selection Committee is composed of the Director and Associates of the JMEUCE.

Notification

The JMEUCE will notify the award winner by 24th May 2017 and will publish the successful student's name and essay on the Centre's website.
