*Public accounts on the 2015 European refugee crisis covered the issue through an individualizing gaze placed on the refugee subject. The refugee in suffering, an experience witnessed by us all, as a spectacle, from the distance: images of crowded tents, boats carrying overflowing numbers of people, children dying on Mediterranean shores. *Trace* turns the gaze outwards, scrutinizing the “space” of the crisis in which people seek refuge. *Trace* is an independent documentary project and was filmed in Greece, UK and Canada in 2017.*
