

Application for a Challenge for Credit

Students who have acquired competence in material covered by a Faculty of Agriculture course may obtain credit for the course by means of a course challenge. Students cannot challenge a course which they have previously taken at Dalhousie University. Only students in "Good" academic standing may challenge a course. The student is to present the form (with appropriate rationale for challenging – sufficient background in the subject to have a reasonable chance of success) to the Instructor. Once the Instructor and Department Head have agreed and signed the form, the student will take the form to the Enrolment Services Center to pay ½ of the course fee. Once approved, the Enrolment Services Center notifies the Instructor that they can offer a Challenge for Credit assessment. The Student completes the assessment and a Pass/Fail grade is submitted to the Enrolment Services Center to be recorded on the student's transcript.
