**Notes:**

- (1) Instrument fee also includes User Fee. Instrument and User Fees payable by April 2, 2018 for Dentistry Qualifying and with 1st installment for Dental Hygiene and DDS students
- (2) Students who have health and/or dental insurance may apply to DSU for reimbursement until September 18, 2018. Proof of coverage is required each academic year
- (3) Student Service Fee includes membership to Dalplex for full-time students from Sept 1, 2017 to Apr 30, 2018.
- (4) Fees are subject to change
- (5) Postgraduate Medicine first installment of \$500 is payable with fall term fees, per Pari-MP agreement.
- (6) Medical Society Fee includes \$59 reg society fee + \$50 Medical student bursary fee. This is assessed to undergrad medical students.  
Exemptions are: Residents, Graduate Students and Post Graduate Medical Students.
- (7) Kit deposit required at start of class for YOS 1. Year 1 revised as of 2014-2015 to be four consecutive terms running from June through August.
- (8) Facilities Renewal -Recreation Fee is to support athletic and recreation facilities, maximum \$180 per academic year.

**International Students:**

Registered students who are not Canadian citizens or permanent residents are required to pay an additional fee referred to as a "Differential Fee". There is a proportional charge for part-time students. Graduate students should refer to the Graduate Studies Calendar to determine the number of years a student is required to pay differential fees.

\*Students enrolled in a Thesis Based Program are charged a reduced fee. Please refer to the Graduate Studies website for a complete list of these programs, [www.dalgrad.dal.ca](http://www.dalgrad.dal.ca)

International and Qualifying Dentistry students are not required to pay international differential fees.

**Graduate Programme Differential Fee - The amount of differential fee will vary depending whether programme requires fees to be paid two or three terms per academic year**

Full-time - \$4,755 per term with fees payable two terms per academic year.

Full-time - \$3,170 per term with fees payable three terms per academic year

Part-time - \$1,585 per term with fees payable two terms per academic year.

Part-time - \$1,056.67 per term, with fees payable three terms per academic year

**Graduate Per Class Differential Fee - The amount of differential fee is based on the number of billing hours taken during a term.**

Full-time - \$4,755 per term (9 billing hours or more)

Part-time - \$317 per billing hour (less than 9 billing hours)

**Graduate Programme Differential Fee (Thesis Based\*) - The amount of differential fee will vary depending whether programme requires fees to be paid two or three terms per academic year.**

Full-time - \$3,285 per term with fees payable two terms per academic year.

Full-time - \$2,190 per term with fees payable three terms per academic year

Part-time - \$1,095 per term with fees payable two terms per academic year.

Part-time - \$730 per term with fees payable three terms per academic year

**Graduate Per Class Differential Fee (Thesis Based\*)- The amount of differential fee is based on the number of billing hours taken during a term.**

Full-time - \$2,190 per term (9 billing hours or more)

Part-time - \$219 per billing hour (less than 9 billing hours)

**International Student Health Insurance Plan:**

Dalhousie International Students will be required to purchase the international health insurance plan each year. International students with coverage may apply to the DSU Health Plan Office before September 18, 2018 for reimbursement. Proof of sufficient, comparable coverage is required each academic year.
