Selection is based on financial need, community involvement and academic performance.

History of Dykeview Farms Ltd.

Originating from the Kidston family farm in Port Williams, Kings County, Nova Scotia, Dykeview Farms Limited was incorporated in 1970, becoming the fifth farming generation on this farm. Dykeview has gone through several phases of growth and crop changes, presently farming approximately 2,500 acres in the Annapolis Valley, from Port Williams, Kings County, to Nictaux, Annapolis County. In 2000, we were pleased to welcome four of our key managers to the ownership group.

In 1985, anticipating sustainable future market growth of existing produce, plus new types of fresh produce, Dykeview Farms strategically formed Nova Agri Inc as our marketing arm. Nova Agri could focus its attention on our customers, while marketing the produce of Dykeview and other local farms.

In the 90's, Dykeview added onions and highbush blueberries to the produce mix. The primary export crops currently grown are potatoes, onions, lettuce, blueberries and other soft fruit; with grains as rotation crops.

We are proud to be farming in Nova Scotia and would not be where we are today without our capable employee base. Overall, we employ 45 full-time and over 120 part-time employees. Through the marketing efforts of Nova Agri, our products are enjoyed in many countries of the world and we have garnered a reputation for quality and service.
