- A portion of tuition fees may be refunded if the withdrawal from a course occurs after September 19, 2023 (Fall Term) & January 22, 2024 (Winter Term).
- Withdrawals before these dates will be completely refunded, but no substitutions will be allowed from a financial perspective after these dates.
- Incidental, society and other miscellaneous fees are non-refundable after the payment due dates of each term.
- For withdrawal from the University, the date the Registrar's Office receives notification determines the amount of the refund.
- Non-attendance does not constitute withdrawal and fees will be payable.
- Refund schedule above does not apply to the University of King's College Journalism or graduate programmes.
