- Withdrawals before these dates will be completely refunded, but no substitutions will be allowed from a financial perspective after these dates.
- For withdrawal from the University, the date the Registrar's Office receives notification determines the amount of the refund.
- Failure to attend does not constitute withdrawal and fees will be payable.
- Incidental, society and other miscellaneous fees are non-refundable after the payment due date of each term.
