- (1) Instrument and User Fees payable with 1st instalment for Dental Hygiene and DDS students
- (2) Students who have health and/or dental insurance may apply to DSU for reimbursement until **TBD** Proof of coverage is required each academic year.
- (3) Student Service Fee includes membership to Dalplex for full-time students from September 1st to April 30th.
- (4) Fees provided as estimates only and are subject to change. Fees may increase each year upon approval by the Board of Governors
- (5) Postgraduate Medicine first installment of \$500 is payable with Fall Term fees, per Pari-MP agreement.
- (6) Medical Society Fee includes \$59 reg society fee + \$50 Medical student bursary fee. This is assessed to undergrad medical students.
Exemptions are: Residents, Graduate Students and Post Graduate Medical Students.
- (7) Facilities Renewal -Recreation Fee is to support athletic and recreation facilities, maximum \$180 per academic year.
- (8) DDH YOS 1 tuition, clinic and mandatory incidental fees are paid each term with the exception of Health Plan (full year) and UPass (8 month) which are paid in September for the year.
- (9) DMCRT means Dalhousie Medical Campus Response Team
- (10) Thesis Required.

IMPORTANT:

*International Students-

Students who are not Canadian citizens (or permanent residents) are also required to pay an Additional International Tuition Fee.

There is a proportional charge for part-time international students.

Per Class International Tuition Fee - The amount of International Tuition fee is based on the number of registered billing hours in each term.

International Student Society Fee - Undergraduate

All International Students are assessed a per term International Society Fee of \$ 5.00

Per Course International Tuition – The amount of International Tuition Fee is based on the number of billing hours taken during a term.

Distance Fees -

In addition to tuition and auxiliary fees, students studying off campus may have additional distance fees related to off-campus instruction.

NS Student Bursary-

Nova Scotian students may be eligible for the Nova Scotia Student Bursary up to \$1283 per year.

Health Plans-

All Full-Time Students Students with sufficient, comparable coverage may apply to opt-out of either policy. Proof of coverage is required each academic year.

You may apply to opt-out of the health and/or dental policies at www.dalonline.dal.ca no later than **TBD**

Note: Students are responsible to ensure Tuition and Fees are paid by payment due date to avoid late fees and interest irrespective of the September 30th opt-out date.

International Students International Students are also provided with basic health insurance plan each year. Students charged with the International Health Plan are able to opt-out from their plan if they can provide proof of enrollment in a comparable health plan.
