We cordially invite you to join us at the 13th International Vaccinium Symposium to be held in Halifax and Charlottetown, Canada from August 24 to 29, 2024. This international symposium brings together all communities of Vaccinium production from research, teaching and extension, to producers, industry representatives, and market specialists.

The symposium will consist of optional pre- and post-conference tours and workshops, a field excursion day, and three days of technical sessions in the fields of breeding, genomics, bioinformatics, production systems, plant physiology, soil fertility and plant nutrition, pest management, post-harvest technologies, health research, marketing and economics, precision agriculture, mechanization, and processing techniques. Keynote presentations including the present and future status of the global blueberry industry; genomes and biotechnology; and the impact of changing climates on the production of Vaccinium species will occur.

Delegates will have the opportunity during pre- and postconference tours and the field excursion day to see some of the world's largest farming and processing facilities for blue berries, Canada's largest strawberry farm, and research facilities at Dalhousie University. In addition to this, attendees will also have the opportunity to visit the Grand Pré and Halifax Citadel National Historic Sites and the birthplace of Canadian confederation. Attendees will also have the opportunity to be involved with an active social program associated with the meeting with a gathering at the historic Alexander Keith's Brewery, a cultural excursion to the north shore of Prince Edward Island ("By the Beach, Over the Coals, and Under the Moon"), and local inde pendent tours. Registration for these functions is required.
