Module Title: Using NVivo

Frequency of formal classes/meetings: 1-2 times per week for a total of three hours per week (will adjust times according to students' schedules)

Module Content and Learning Objectives

This module will allow students to learn basic and advanced features of NVivo qualitative data analysis software. Features include, but are not limited to, loading documents for analysis, defining codes, assigning codes, adding comments, applying attributes, data retrieval, and data analysis. Classes will be taught through face-to-face (or online) lectures and video tutorials. Students will demonstrate their mastery of NVivo by using all the elements necessary to conduct an analysis [note: students will not have to actually conduct their own study, but will need to demonstrate they can use all the NVivo features to do so].

Method of Evaluation:

Presentation or Video demonstrating use of basic and advanced features of NVivo including loading documents, defining and assigning codes, adding comments, applying attributes, data retrieval, and data analysis (organizing and extracting coded material).

Any restrictions on enrollment: number of students, background preparation or prerequisite courses
