How long are you planning to stay in Canada?	Temporarily – more than 6 months
What is your current country/territory of residence?	Canada
Do you have a Provincial Attestation Letter?	No
Do you qualify for an Exception?	Yes/No. If you currently have a valid study permit you qualify for an exception.
Which exception do you qualify for?	I am an applicant that meets another <u>exception on the IRCC</u> website
What is your current immigration status in Canada?	Student
Are you accompanying a family member who has status in Canada?	No (Yes if you have a family member who is in Canada on a study permit, work permit or visitor visa)
Do you also want to apply for a work permit?	Depends on whether you are in a co-op program. (You can apply for a co-op work permit at the same time if you are required to do co-op by your faculty and department).
When does your status in Canada expire?	
Have you had a medical exam performed by a CIC authorized panel	<i>Yes</i> or <i>No</i> depending on the time of the medical exam performed. If
physician (doctor) within the last 12 months?	yes, upload an <i>eMedical Information Sheet</i> or call the IRCC call center at 1-888-242-2100 to obtain your <i>UMI#</i> . Afterwards, create a word document with the following info: date and country you completed a medical exam and enter the UMI# given by IRCC. Your online application will prompt you to submit a confirmation of medical examination.
Have you lived in a designated country or territory for more than six months in the last year?	If you have lived in a country for more than 6 months in the last year and your country is listed as an immigration medical is required on the IRCC website (www.cic.gc.ca/english/information/medical/dcl.asp), then you must answer YES, otherwise NO
Do you want to submit an application for a family member?	Family member is defined as a spouse or common-law partner, dependent children, and their dependent children. You may submit an application for a family member who is in Canada.
Are you giving someone access to your application?	No
