We honor our responsibility as Treaty People and commit to working in partnership with Mi'kmaq peoples and communities to foster a more equitable province.





### Two Provincial Immigration Programs to Meet Labour Market Demand

## NOVA SCOTIA NOMINEE PROGRAM (NSNP)

Candidate-driven process

### **Common Requirements**

#### **Full-Time & Permanent Job Offers:**

Required for prospective candidates in both programs.

### **Active Domestic Recruitment:**

Must show efforts to recruit Canadians and permanent residents.

### **Employer Registration Certificate (ERC):**

Mandatory for hiring foreign nationals.

# Atlantic Immigration Program (AIP) Employer-led process

## These are Permanent immigration programs with Work Permit options available.

Both programs are intended to support NS employers in filling permanent labour market needs and allow foreign nationals to apply for work permits so that they may come to Nova Scotia and work while their Permanent Residence (PR) applications are being processed.



## NATIONAL OCCUPATION CLASSIFICATION (NOC)

TEER	Description	Examples of Positions
TEER 0	Management occupations	Senior & middle management occupations
TEER 1	Occupations that usually require a university degree	Nurses, Doctors, Accountants, HR professionals, Engineers, IT professionals, Lawyers
TEER 2	Occupations that usually require: - a college diploma - apprenticeship training (2 or more years) - supervisory occupations	Early Childhood Educators, Graphic Designers, Retails Sales Supervisors, Cooks, Electricians, Carpenters, Mechanics, Bookkeepers, Automotive service technicians
TEER 3	Occupations that usually require: - a college diploma - apprenticeship training, less than 2 years or - more than 6 months of on-the-job-training	Continuing Care Assistants, Photographers, Heavy Equipment Operators, Financial Sales Representatives, Cooks, Hairstylists, Roofers, Painters, Transport Truck Drivers
TEER 4	Occupations that usually require - a high school diploma, or - several weeks of on-the-job training	Hotel Front Desk Clerks, Retail Salespersons, Bartenders Customer Service Representatives, Security Guards Fiberglass Boat Assemblers
TEER 5	Occupations that usually need short-term work demonstration and no formal education	Construction Trades Helpers & Labourers, Cashiers, Material Handlers, Food & Beverage Servers, Cleaners Food Counter Attendants & Kitchen Helpers




# NOVA SCOTIA NOMINEE PROGRAM: TWO STEP PROCESS

NOMINATION APPLICATION
(Provincial Jurisdiction)

#### **LED BY CANDIDATE**

- Eligibility depends on stream requirements
- Submit complete application with employer documents
- If approved, candidate gets a nomination certificate


 Candidate applies for permanent residence with nomination certificate



## NSNP: Skilled Worker

### Permanent full-time job offer from a NS Employer

- 1 year of related work experience
- TEER 4 & 5, 6 months of work experience with employer
- Age 21 to 55
- High school certificate
- English or French language ability
- Financial resources to settle in Nova Scotia
- Intention to settle in Nova Scotia
- Legal status if in Canada



# NSNP: International Graduate Entrepreneur

The International Graduate Entrepreneur Stream is for candidates who want to live permanently in Nova Scotia while owning and actively managing a Nova Scotia business;

- Minimum ownership is 33.33% of the enterprise with one year experience managing the business
- Completed a minimum two-year full-time program at a Nova Scotia University or Nova Scotia Community College
- English or French language ability
- Financial resources to settle in Nova Scotia
- Intention to settle in Nova Scotia
- Legal status if in Canada

# NSNP: NOVA SCOTIA INTERNATIONAL GRADUATES IN DEMAND

**Permanent full-time job offer** from a NS Employer in one of these professions:

- Paramedical occupations
- Pharmacy technicians
- Nurse aides, orderlies, and patient service associates
- Early childhood educators and assistants
- Age 21 to 55
- Have finished a course of at least 30 weeks in length 50% minimum in NS within 3 years of submitting your application
- Have certifications issued by NS regulatory bodies required for the job
- English or French language ability



### **NSNP 200 – EMPLOYER INFORMATION FORM**

### Required form from Employer to support PNP application

- Employee information
- Employer information
- General information
- Position information
- Mandatory Recruitment activities
- Support and Retention Plan
- Temporary work permit
- Authority to collect and disclose information
- Declaration of authorized signing officer

### **Duty to provide accurate information**

### Include all required documents:

- Signed copy of accepted Job Offer
- Detailed conditions of employment
- Details position description (roles/responsibilities/qualifications/education and experience required)
- Copy of ERC (if required)

#### **LED BY EMPLOYER**

- Connection to a SPO
- Employer starts training process
- Employer meets criteria
- If approved, employer is designated under the AIP

#### **LED BY EMPLOYER**

- Job offer meets criteria
- Employer and candidate create settlement plan
- Employer completes all required training
- If approved, candidate receives endorsement certificate



## ATLANTIC IMMIGRATION PROGRAM

### Eligibility

- Employers must become <u>designated</u> and have positions <u>endorsed</u> by the Province
- No age restriction
- Language: CLB 5 for occupations TEER 0-3; and CLB 4 for occupations in TEER 4
- Educational Credential Assessment (ECA) required for those without Canadian credentials
- 1 year of work experience
