WRITING REQUIREMENT COURSE OPTIONS:

- **English:** ENGL/CRWR 1030.06* (single term); **or two of:** ENGL1005.03, ENGL 1015.03, ENGL 1025.03, ENGL1040.03, ENGL 1050.03, ENGL 1100.03
- **German:** GERM 1026.03 **and** 1027.03
- **History:** HIST 1510.06* (single term)
- **Journalism:** JOUR 1002.03 **and** 1003.03
- **Oceanography:** OCEA 1001.03 **and** 1002.03
- **Performance:** PERF 1000.03 **and** 1 of 1001.03 or 1002.03
- **Philosophy:** PHIL 1810.03 **and** 1820.03
- **Political Science:** POLI 1001.03 **and** 1002.03
- **Russian Studies:** RUSN 1020.03 **and** 1070.03
- **Sustainability:** SUST 1000.06* (single term)

NOTES: * 6-credit-hour courses in a single term are the equivalent of two courses in the same term; these cover both Writing Requirement boxes, meaning you will swap another box from the same term and take that course in the other term instead.

Select SUST 1000.06 if you are interested in the **BMgmt Major in Environment, Sustainability & Society (ESS)**.

6-cr-hr single-term writing courses in fall: If you choose ENGL/CRWR 1030 or SUST 1000, you will take one of ECON 1101, MGMT 1501 or MGMT 1601 in the winter term instead; swapping places with the Winter Writing Requirement.

Students wishing to declare a **Minor** (in another subject area outside of the Faculty of Management) should consult the appropriate department/Faculty. Minor requirements are typically considered elective courses.

With the exception of ECON 1101, ECON 1102 and the Writing Requirement, all Management courses can be found under 'Management' on the [Academic Timetable](#) or in the [Undergraduate Academic Calendar](#).
