

Study Permit Extension Online Eligibility Questionnaire Guide

****Please note that not all questions and answers are listed here****

Questions	Answers
What would you like to do in Canada?	Study
How long are you planning to stay in Canada?	Temporarily – more than 6 months
What is your current country/territory of residence?	Canada
Do you have a provincial or territorial attestation letter or meet an exception from submitting a provincial or territorial attestation letter?	Yes, I meet an exception from submitting a provincial or territorial attestation letter. <i>Note: If you are a transfer student from another DLI, applying for student status restoration or changing level of study at Dalhousie, you may require a PAL.</i>
What is your current immigration status in Canada?	Student
Are you a student residing in Canada who is changing your designated learning institution?	No (or Yes if you are coming to Dalhousie from another Designated Learning Institution)
Are you accompanying a family member who has status in Canada?	No (or Yes if you have a family member who is in Canada on a study permit, work permit or visitor visa)
Do you also want to apply for a work permit?	No (or Yes, I wish to apply for a CoOp Work Permit if you are required by your Faculty to apply for a coop work permit)
When does your status in Canada expire?	Study permit expiry date (yyyy-month-dd)
Have you had a medical exam performed by an IRCC authorized panel physician (doctor) within the last 12 months?	Yes or No depending on when the medical exam was performed. If yes, upload an eMedical Information Sheet .
A medical exam is needed before you submit your application for foreign nationals who: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> want to stay in Canada for more than 6 months and have lived in one or more designated countries or territories for more than six months in the past year or; intend to work in one of the following jobs ... 	

Do you fit into one of these categories?	Yes or No based on your circumstances.
Have you lived in a designated country or territory for more than six months in the last year?	If you have lived in a country for more than 6 months in the last year and this country is listed as one of the designated countries where an immigration medical is required, you will need to answer YES.
Do you want to submit an application for a family member?	Family member is defined as a spouse, common-law partner, dependent children, and their dependent children. You may submit an application for a family member who is in Canada.
Are you giving someone access to your application?	No
In the past 10 years, have you given your fingerprints and photo (biometrics) for an application to come to Canada? (required)	Yes
There are fees associated with this application. Will you be paying your fees or are you fee exempt?	Yes, I will be paying my application fees.
Are you able to make a digital copy of your documents with a scanner or camera?	Yes
Will you be paying your application fees online? To pay online, you need a Visa, MasterCard or American Express.	Yes
