



The industry

- Business events attracted 35.3 million participants, with \$29 billion in direct spending
- Delivered \$27.5 billion to Canada's gross domestic product (GDP) – approx. 1.5% of Canada's GDP
- Contributed \$8.5 billion in taxes and service fees to all levels of governments
- Supported employment of more than 200,000 full-year jobs directly
- More than 585,000 business events held in Canada, in more than 2,000 venues

Successful events have powerful branding and messaging







































Tips and tricks
