## Events

Halifax : Studley, Carleton, & Sexton

The committee continues to host traditional events e.g.:

 <u>Washer-Toss BBQ</u>: To be held again this summer (tentatively Thursday June 21st). It has become our signature event that consistently attracts 100+ members and can be offered at a fraction of the cost per attendee figure of any other event that we do that involves food.

We also worked together to host other DPMG events this year including:

- <u>Friday Fitness</u>: a lunchtime boot camp-style fitness class that runs from mid
  September until mid-June usually in 10-week sessions. It has traditionally been in the
  Studley gym dance studio, but has recently moved into our brand new fitness facility.
