Events

Halifax : Studley, Carleton, & Sexton

The committee continues to host traditional events e.g.:

- <u>Washer-Toss BBQ</u>: Held Thursday June 21st 2018 & Thursday July 4th 2019. This has become our signature event that consistently attracts 100+ members (~150 in 2019) and can be offered at a fraction of the cost per attendee figure of any other event that we do that involves food.
