The University Transportation & Security Committee met monthly from September 2018 through June 2019. There were no DPMG specific items on the agenda this year, although most of the topics we discuss are of a broad scope that involves DPMG and other members of our larger university community, e.g:

- Parking management (e.g. pricing, fielding complaints, managing around construction, winter snow removal, etc.)
 - There will be no increase in parking fees, across all permit types, for the next academic year.
- Security incidents, trends, & strategies
- Encouraging sustainable transportation:
 - University Avenue bike lane pilot project
 - Electric vehicle (EV) charging facilities (e.g. signage & maintenance strategy) & EV Showcase
 - o The Green Corridor project
