## TEN IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW

- 1. Speak English at all times.
- 2. Attendance at classes and workshops is mandatory.
- 3. Be polite and respectful to your instructors, monitors, building staff and to each other at all times.

- 5. If you hear the fire alarm, please exit the building immediately.
