- -All new proposed driveway accesses must meet the HRM Streets By-Law S-300.
- -The latest edition of Nova Scotia Temporary Workplace Traffic Control Manual applies and the Halifax Regional Municipality Traffic Control Manual Supplement (most recent version) also applies.
- -Applicant is responsible to notify residents and businesses affected 5 days prior to the start of the street closure
- -Street closure on South St approved on July 14 to 25, 2025 ONLY
- -Street to remain closed overnight.
- -Overnight work approved July 16 at 9:30pm to July 17 at 6am ONLY.

  Exemption to Noise ByLaw N-200 due to Halifax Water shutting off water. Overnight work will create the least impact to nearby residents and businesses.
