

McCain Exterior Envelope Project - 2-Week Lookahead June 3-17

Between now and September 2025 the exterior, roof and windows of the Marion McCain Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences Building are being renewed,

Most construction activities will take place between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Key Construction Activities June 3-17:

Site set up –A fence will be erected on both Seymour and LeMarchant streets to set up an area for the workers to store construction supplies. As of Wednesday June 5, the LeMarchant Street sidewalk will be closed for the duration of the project. The Seymour street sidewalk will also be closed but only until August 31. We have received all necessary permits from HRM for this work.

Scaffolding will be erected on both the Seymour Street and LeMarchant Street sides of the building starting Friday, June 7.

The fencing and scaffolding will impact one of the exits and there will be more information as it is known.

Bird Construction is the contractor for this work. They have set up a site office in room 1195. The site supervisor is Scott Boyd and you will see him around the building frequently.

Siding Demolition – Workers will begin removing existing siding once the scaffolding is up – the week of Monday, June 10. The noise from the demolition will be noticeable.

Test Window Installation – A new window will be installed in Room 1122 to validate the construction process going forward.
