

McCain Exterior Envelope Project - 2-Week Lookahead July 1 – July 14

Between now and September 2025 the exterior, roof and windows of the Marion McCain Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences Building are being renewed.

Most construction activities will take place between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays & some weekends.

Key Construction Activities July 1-July 14:

Siding & Decking Demolition & New Cladding Prep on East & West Side– Workers will continue removing existing siding & decking on the LeMarchant St side & Seymour St side. The noise from the demolition & new construction will be noticeable. Workers will be accessing patios from the patio doors located in each department common area. The patio door locks will be switched to a construction key with restricted access.

New Window Installation – Full window installations will continue as follows. Note: these dates are meant to be guidelines as the earliest date possible but may fall on the few days following.

Tuesday July 2, 2024 - Window Installation Rooms 3114, 3116.

Wednesday July 3, 2024 - Window Installation Rooms 3126, 3128.

Thursday July 4, 2024 - Window Installation Rooms 3106, 3108, 3112.

Friday July 5, 2024 - Window Installation Rooms 3118, 3120, 3124.

Monday July 8, 2024 – Window Installation Rooms 3130, 3132, 3136.

Tuesday July 9, 2024 – Window Installation Rooms 1174, 1180, 1186.

Wednesday July 10, 2024 – Window Installation Rooms 1190, 1192, 1196.

Thursday July 11, 2024 – Window Installation Rooms 3172, 3174.

Some of you may see plywood on your new window instead of glass, this glass is on order and will arrive shortly, the glass will be replaced from the outside, restricting interruption in your office space.

Roofing – Roofing materials being replaced on the “build-outs” or “houses” on the LeMarchant St & Seymour St sides starting this week.

Exiting Impacts - July 2-9 the SW LeMarchant St exit will be blocked off to allow for window replacement above the doors and scaffolding install. In case of emergency, we will stop work and direct traffic out of the building.
