Safe Job Procedures

These job procedures are to be followed at all times to ensure effectiveness in employee safety, production, quality of work and overall loss prevention.

- Read Key Blank code on key you wish to duplicate. E.g. Schlage "C" blank
- Select a new uncut Schlage key blank stamped with the letter "C".
- Set master key in the left side rail jig clamp using the fold down alignment bar to properly set travel distance and secure the clamp.
- Set uncut blank in the right side rail jig clamp and use the fold down alignment bar to properly set travel distance and secure the clamp.
- Turn on the cutter and unlock the carriage lock button.
- With a slow steady motion move the carriage travel level to the right end of travel and then back to the left end of travel for cutting / duplication to take place.

- Repeat if necessary.
- Tilt travel carriage back towards you to engage the carriage lock button mechanism thus holding the keys off the duplicator and cutting wheel.
- Turn cutter OFF and allow the cutting wheel to stop turning before removing keys from clamps.
