

# Dalhousie University

## Tuition and Fee Recommendations 2022-23

The changes recommended to student fees for 2022-23 are described in the following schedules as attached:

<sup>1</sup>The proposed Tuition and Facilities Renewal Fees for 2022-23 include a 3% increase according to the recommendation in the Budget Advisory Committee report, "Draft Operating Budget plan for 2022-23". Tuition for international students (undergraduate and masters (non-thesis) programs) beginning their programs in the fall of 2019 or later will increase by the 3% general increase plus an additional \$1,473 (full time rate) in accordance with the multiyear fee approved in April 2019.

**Proposed Tuition and Facilities Renewal Fees for 2022-2023**  
(Effective April 1, 2022 unless otherwise noted)

**NOTICE TO READER:** Tuition fees are assessed either on a program fee or per course based on the billing hours for the course (1 half credit class is normally 3 billing hours). A student enrolled in a full course load of 10 half credits over the fall and winter terms would normally be charged for 30 billing hours, (e.g. using the 2022-23 rates below, tuition for an Undergraduate Arts student enrolled in a full course load for the fall and winter terms would be 30 x \$286.50 = \$8,595).

The Province of Nova Scotia provides students studying at a Nova Scotia University an automatic bursary that is applied directly to reduce tuition paid. The bursary reduces fees by \$1,283 per year for students enrolled in a full course load. Using the Undergraduate Arts example above, the net tuition for a Nova Scotia student is \$7,312 (\$8,595 less \$1,283). The fee rates in the schedule below do not reflect the application of the bursary.

## Notes to 2022-23 Proposed Residence and Meal Plan Rates:

<sup>1</sup> The 2022-23 proposed residence rates include an average increase of 3% across all residences to support maintenance of facilities, and increases in utility and compensation costs. The 2022-23 year is also the third year of a 5 year realignment of the Halifax Campus rates. This realignment will result in reducing the variance between rates in older and newer residences to reflect extensive improvements that have been made to the older residences over the past five years. The rates on newer residences will increase by 2.5% while rates in older residences will increase by 3.5%.

## Additional Rate Information:

- a) Rates do not include the non-refundable application fee of \$50. Halifax rates do not include the Residence Council Society Fee (\$40 -\$50). Truro residence rates include a \$70 laundry fee.
- b) Residence fees include all entertainment, internet and Wi-Fi services in all residence buildings.
- c) LeMarchant Place rooms are charged a premium over the traditional single rate for Risley and Fountain. This facility offers suite style rooms with kitchen facilities and a reduced mandatory meal plan is available for these residents.
- d) Between 2016-17 and 2019-20 an average of \$3.7 million per year was invested in maintenance in residence facilities. Less work was completed than normal in 20/21 and 21/22 as a result of the pandemic. The residence budget in 2022-23 will return to prioritizing investment in facilities.

<sup>2</sup> Total with meal plan includes food service costs which flow through to food service providers on the campuses. Fees include a 4.7% increase in (Truro) and a 5.4% increase (Halifax) and relate primarily to increased cost of food. These increases are related to inflation increases and specifically food prices which are forecasted to increase across all food categories between 5 to 7%. A meal plan is mandatory when living in a Traditional Residence:

- a) The Halifax Campus Total with Meal Plan assumes the Freedom Plan is selected, which allows access to the dining hall during open hours.
- b) The Truro Campus Total with Meal Plan includes the 7 day meal plan.

<sup>3</sup> Non-Traditional Residence agreements are for 8 months - September through April.

<sup>4</sup> Meal Plans less than the equivalent of 10 meals per week attract HST. Rate shown includes HST.
