BMO Travel Card - Insurance Coverage

The following is a summary of the insurance coverage that is provided when using the BMO Travel card.

Please read the Certificate of Insurance that is provided with your card for details of the coverage, exclusions and the conditions that apply to the coverage.

CAR RENTAL

- The cost of the rental must be made on the travel card.
- The Collision Damage Waiver (CDW) offered by the rental company must be declined for for this coverage to be effective.
- The rental must be from a commercial rental agency and must be for business purpose only.
- Coverage is limited to loss or damage to the rental vehicle
- Includes Accidental Death & Dismemberment benefits.
- Include car rental personal effects benefit as excess coverage up to \$1,000 per person and \$2,000 per account
- Does not included 3rd Party automobile, property damage or personal injury liability insurance.

TRIP ASSISTANCE

- Includes baggage delay benefit
- Reimbursement for the cost of a one way fare for the primary cardholder to return home due to a death in the immediate family.
- Includes Accidental Death & Dismemberment benefits while riding as a passenger in a common carrier.

The coverage does not include travel medical coverage.
