




Importance of the Atlantic Ocean and Marine Environment to Atlantic Canada's Economy





Threat Level to Health of Atlantic Canada's Ocean






Atlantic Herring (Gulf (4T) & 4X5




4T – Gulf of St. Lawrence

4X5Y – SW Nova Scotia Herring


Northern Cod






Below the critical zone, fishing should be kept to lowest Possible levels, in 2019 Northern cod was 2nd highest landings for groundfish in Atlantic Canada

Bycatch in Atlantic Halibut Fishery






Atlantic Halibut population is increasing – but major bycatch species are all assessed by COSEWIC as endangered, threatened or special concern: Stewardship opportunity
