# 2016/17 QS World University Rankings



Results Released: Sept. 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016

#### **SUMMARY**

Results: Overall Rank: 283<sup>rd</sup>

The Quacquarelli Symonds World University Rankings (QS) features more than 900 universities. Rankings are also available in 36 subject areas, and 5 faculty areas.

Rankings use 6 indicators, drawn from a peer review survey, employer survey and data provided by each university:

- 1) Academic Reputation (40%)
- 2) Employer Reputation (10%)
- 3) Citations per Faculty (20%) \*
- 4) Student/Faculty Ratio (20%)
- 5) Proportion of international students (5%)
- 6) Proportion of international faculty (5%)

\*NOTE: For the 2016/17 release, QS has made several changes in methodology, as follows:

- In 2015, QS introduced an affiliation cap, whereby papers with authors representing 10 or more affiliations were excluded from citations analysis. This year, a variable cap was applied, to ensure that no more than 0.1% of papers in any discipline be excluded.
- 2) This year the rankings were extended to 916 institutions from 891. In order to ensure this trend can continue yet maintain a consistent measure for those already included, an adjustment has been made to the standardization method used for each indicator locking the calculation of mean and standard deviation to the top 700 institutions in each indicator.

While, these changes have not had the impact as those made in 2015, they have still resulted in some movement in the rankings.
