



Instructions for Applying to *Dalhousie University Faculty of Engineering* for *Diploma/Certificate of Engineering Graduates*

Please apply for admission by April 30, 2026.

These instructions are for students finishing their second year and graduating with a Diploma of Engineering (or equivalent) in May 2026. It also applies to any students who will meet the Diploma requirements by August 31, 2026, and plan on attending Dalhousie in the Fall 2026 or non-coop Industrial Engineering students who plan on starting their studies in Summer 2026.

Industrial Engineering Accelerated (non-coop)

Students following the accelerated (non-coop) Summer 2026 entry to Industrial Engineering must **a) apply for a Fall 2026 admission** and **b) email Jason.Lecoure@dal.ca and provide a copy of their unofficial transcript and request a summer 2026 admission** to Industrial Engineering.

International Students

International students who require an **early conditional admission in order to apply for a study permit** should contact Justin.Deturbide@dal.ca immediately upon submission of your application.



Admission to Engineering

Admissions to your Engineering program will occur in **early June** assuming you have completed all requirements for admission by the end of the Winter 2026 term.

Admitted students will be sent a registration and welcome package from their receiving departments and will receive an admissions letter from the Dalhousie Admissions Office. Ensure you pay your registration deposit as instructed. **Failure to pay your deposit means that you will be unable to register for classes.**

If you will be completing your remaining requirements over the Summer 2026 term, you must email engineering@dal.ca upon completion of your final course(s) notifying them you are ready for assessment for admission. Please include evidence demonstrating completion of any summer classes with your email. You must also submit final official transcripts to engineering@dal.ca prior to starting classes in the Fall term.

Submitting Transcripts

You must submit your official transcripts to the Director of your Engineering Program or to the Engineering Secretary. If you do not submit your transcripts you will not be admitted to Dalhousie and you will be unable to register for classes. Please contact your Director of Engineering if you have questions about submitting your transcripts and the deadlines you must meet to do so.

Students completing remaining course work over the Summer term must submit their official transcripts to registrar@dal.ca directly from the institution where the course was taken.
