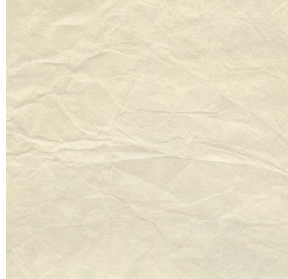


# Architecture Material Sorting Guide

Please reuse material if possible. If not possible, then sort material into the following streams to increase diversion from the landfill. Ordering material that can be re-used or easily recycled is a recommended solution.

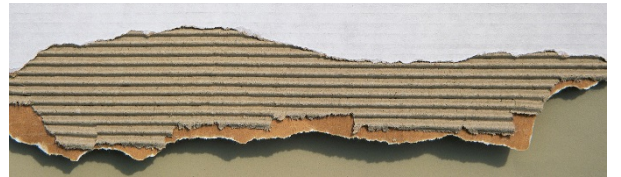
## Paper – Paper Bin

- Clean paper (white and coloured)
- Parchment/tracing paper
- Cardstock (incl. glued layers)
- Boxboard



## Cardboard – Flatten, place beside paper bin

- Cardboard (incl. glued layers), collect SEPARATELY from paper



## Construction & Demolition Collection

### C&D Bin

- Clean wood (reuse as much as possible)
- Treated and composite wood (incl. painted wood, plywood, MDF; layered)
- Plexiglass/Acrylic



### Metal Bin

- Metal scrap, shavings, and wires

### Other

- Styrofoam/EPS \*Ask laser cutting room faculty/staff (material will be picked up by FM for recycling)



## Garbage – Garbage Bin

- Foam mounted backing
- Photographs
- Inseparable composite materials
- Pencils and pens
