Extramural Courses for BEDS Students

The BEDS program does not include any electives, so most students will not be concerned with courses elsewhere; however, in exceptional situations (e.g., missing prerequisite; replacement for a BEDS transfer credit), a student may have to take a course at another Dalhousie department or another university. This should be done only after consulting with the Undergraduate Coordinator. The class time cannot conflict with your BEDS courses. A BEDS student who is doing a full course load (15 credit hours) normally is not permitted to take an additional course.

Procedure

a) To take a course from another Dalhousie department

Just register for it, then notify the Architecture office that you have done so. No written permission is needed from the School of Architecture unless this course would raise your total load for the term to 18 credit hours. In this case, you would go to Dal Online > Web for Students > Waiver Application form and submit a waiver of an academic regulation. The grade for the course eventually will appear on your academic record. A grade that is in letter format will be counted in your BEDS GPA.

b) To take a course from another university
