COMPETITION DETAILS:

- Concerto Night is a competition open to all students currently enrolled in Applied Studies at the Fountain School of Performing Arts. **Winners will perform their chosen repertoire with the Dalhousie Symphony Orchestra on Tuesday, March 21, 2023, in the Rebecca Cohn Auditorium.**
- To apply, submit this completed form to the FSPA Office (Dal Arts Centre 514) or via email to performingarts@dal.ca by **October 17, 2022**. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- The competition will take place on **Saturday, October 29, 2022**, in Rooms 121 and 406.
- The competition jury will consist of Applied Study faculty members from the Fountain School.
- Previous participants may apply at the discretion of their Applied Study instructor.
- On the competition date, applicants will perform an excerpt (10-minute maximum) from the concerto or operatic repertoire they plan to perform.
- **Pieces must be performed from memory.** Certain exceptions may be made (ex. contemporary works), but only with advance permission from the competition jury. Students requesting exceptions must do so **in writing** by the application deadline.
- The competition jury will make recommendations for the Concerto Night program based on the results of the competition. The final choice of soloists will depend on programming, availability and cost of parts, and orchestral instrumentation required.
- It is expected that Applied Study instructors will work with applicants to bring them to performance standard by the competition date.
