FINANCIAL AID

- Funding is available from **Dalhousie's International Student Services SWIF (Study/Work International Fund)** program. Up to \$1000-\$2000 may be available to students who meet the requirements. IMPORTANT:

- A non-refundable deposit of \$350 will be required **by January 31** in order for you to register for this class. This deposit will be put toward your tuition fee. If you have a credit at student accounts, they can take this amount from your existing credit.
- **YOU MUST HAVE A PASSPORT THAT IS VALID SIX MONTHS AFTER YOUR RETURN DATE IN ORDER TO TRAVEL.** The Canadian Passport Office is located in the Aliant building at the foot of Spring Garden Road, on Barrington Street. There are sometimes long line-ups so don't delay if you don't have a valid passport or if your passport is near its expiration date.
