## **IMPORTANT:**

- A non-refundable deposit of \$350 will be required **by January 31** in order for you to register for this class. This deposit will be put toward your tuition fee. If you have a credit at student accounts, they can take this amount from your existing credit.
- YOU MUST HAVE A PASSPORT THAT IS VALID SIX MONTHS AFTER YOUR RETURN DATE IN ORDER TO TRAVEL. The Canadian Passport Office is located in the Aliant building at the foot of Spring Garden Road, on Barrington Street. There are sometimes long line-ups so don't delay if you don't have a valid passport or if your passport is near its expiration date.
