Lyn Gratwick-Theatre Arts Guild Scholarship in Costume Studies

APPLICATION DEADLINE: October 15, 2020

In December 2010, the late John Gratwick graciously founded the **Lyn Gratwick-Theatre Arts Guild Scholarship in Costume Studies** in memory of his wife, Lyn, who was for many years an expert costumer for the Theatre Arts Guild, one of Canada's oldest community theatres.

To honour the memory of Lyn Gratwick, this scholarship will be given annually to one or more student(s) in the Costume Studies program who has or have demonstrated artistic excellence in costume-making for theatre and intend(s) to pursue a career as a costumer for a professional theatre company or an historic site. Eligible applicants must have completed at least three years of study in their undergraduate program at Dalhousie.

The value of this year's award is **\$1800**.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Students must submit a letter of application to the Fountain School's Student Affairs Committee.

Please include the following details in your letter:

- Discuss how you have a demonstrated artistic excellence in costume-making. For example, have you successfully created a challenging costume or costumes? Have you been invited to work for a theatre company or stage production where you have been required to build costumes? Have you achieved high grades in costume-related classes?
- Discuss how your career plans fit into the award criteria. Do you plan to pursue a career in professional theatre or in historical site costuming? What steps do you hope to take to achieve your goals?
