

MUSIC BURSARIES

APPLICATION DEADLINE: OCTOBER 15, 2020

Music students in financial need are encouraged to apply for the following FOUR bursaries:

Charles and Mary MacLennan Bursaries in Music

- Awarded to **THREE** undergraduate students in a Music degree program in any idiom who demonstrate artistic excellence
- Students must have completed at least one academic year to be eligible
- The value of each award is **\$2500**

Kathleen Stewart Memorial Bursary in Music

- Awarded to one or more undergraduate student(s) in a Music degree program who demonstrate financial need and have shown academic excellence as demonstrated by GPA in the relevant classes
- First preference will be given to students studying piano and second preference will be given to students studying voice
- The value of this year's award is **\$1500**

2. Write a strong letter describing:

- a) your financial need**
- b) your commitment to, and excellence in, the field of Music**

Examples of what to include in your letter:

- Make note of circumstances that demonstrate your financial need, including details of your Canada Student Loan. If you are not eligible for a student loan, please give details to support your case for financial need.
- Provide details demonstrating your pursuit of "artistic excellence." For example, have you successfully performed in a solo setting (i.e. summer opera or instrumental programs, off-campus recitals, or festivals?) Have you been invited to perform with any off-campus organizations? Please note any other performance activities that may be relevant.
