JOPLING AWARD FOR OUT-OF-COUNTRY THEATRE STUDIES

APPLICATION DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 15, 2024

This award for students enrolled in Dalhousie University degree programs in Theatre is intended to enhance their knowledge of theatre through study in another country during the summer period. The award, valued at \$3,000 for 2024, may be divided between two applicants at the discretion of the Student Affairs Committee. The successful recipient will have demonstrated financial need and a minimum GPA of 3.3 in the 2023-24 academic year.

Criteria:

1. Applicants must be currently enrolled full-time in a Theatre degree program at Dalhousie University and have completed a minimum of one year (both fall and winter semesters) of their program of study.
2. Applicants must provide proof of acceptance by an institution outside of Canada in a program of study meeting the approval of the Student Affairs Committee. It is not mandatory that the summer study be eligible for credit towards a Dalhousie degree program.
3. Although the award is for study in a country other than Canada, this does not preclude the eligible recipient(s) being enrolled in a “study abroad” course offered by Dalhousie University or another Canadian educational institution, with a portion of that course being conducted in Canada.

To apply:

1. Write a letter of 250-500 words explaining how your intended course of study outside the country will enhance your overall educational goals.
