ENGLISH/FRENCH ESSAY

2 pages, typewritten and double-spaced.

Include information on your future educational and professional plans and what steps you have taken and will be taking to achieve these goals. How do you plan to arrange your Russian studies leading up to the summer term?

RUSSIAN ESSAY

2 pages, typewritten and double-spaced.

Write an autobiography in Russian, with no assistance other than the use of a dictionary. Include a description of your academic and non-academic interests and activities in the autobiography.

The completed Application Form and both essays should be submitted via email to rpa@dal.ca prior to the deadline – please ensure that you rename your application files to LastName_DocumentType

PASSPORT CHECK

Passports must be valid for at least two years after your planned date of departure from Russia. If your passport expires prior to that, you will need to renew your passport right away.

If you are accepted to the program, we will require a scanned page from the updated passport, and will also temporarily require your physical passport to obtain your Russian visa.

FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid for the Russian Program Abroad is very limited. You are urged to investigate thoroughly scholarship and loan opportunities on your own campus or through civic groups in your home and school communities. Your campus financial administrator and study abroad advisor can assist you with this.

TELEPHONE INTERVIEW
