About the opportunity The Faculty of Computer Science is seeking candidates for a 3-year limited term instructor position.

The position will primarily involve delivering courses on technical and professional communication skills at both undergraduate and graduate levels; and participating in other Faculty administration, student affairs, and student advising. This position involves the delivery of courses such as CSCI 2100: Communication Skills: Oral and Written and CSCI 5100: Written and Oral Communication Skills, as well as other core communication and professional competency courses.

The successful candidate to this position must meet the following requirements:

- At least a Masters degree, with preference given to candidates who hold a PhD.
- Experience in teaching communication courses at the university level

Additional desirable qualifications are as follows:

- A history of excellence in teaching communication courses as well as academic writing at the university level, particularly to large and diverse classes
- Ability to motivate the need for strong communication skills in the software and technology industries
- Experience in teaching large and diverse classes with large numbers of ESL students
- Experience or interest in technology-related fields such as computer science, engineering, history of science and technology, or related fields.
- Experience in academic administration, committee work, and student advising
