

## Limited term (3-year) Instructor in Computer Science

Faculty of Computer Science, Dalhousie University.

The Faculty of Computer Science is seeking candidates for the position of Instructor for a 3-year limited term position. The position will primarily involve developing and teaching first and second -year undergraduate courses targeted at students outside of the Faculty of Computer Science, and participating in Faculty administration and undergraduate affairs, such as the Curriculum Committee and undergraduate student advising.

Candidates for this position must have at least a Masters degree in Computer Science or related discipline. The successful candidate must be willing to deliver large general interest courses to students from a variety of backgrounds and disciplines. The ability to engage and motivate large classes, and to excite students from other disciplines about computer science will be prioritized. Previous experience in teaching large diverse university classes and developing computing courses for students from other disciplines and/or lower level computer science courses will be considered an asset.

Eligible candidates are encouraged to apply for this position with a package including a C.V., cover letter, a teaching dossier and the email addresses of three references. The dossier must provide any available and pertinent evidences of teaching effectiveness and innovation. The applicant **must** also include the Equity Self-Identification form as part of their application material (see URL below).
