The Dalhousie University School of Occupational Therapy is pleased to announce that we will be offering an AMPS course this July!

What is the AMPS The AMPS is an internationally recognized occupational therapy assessment, used to evaluate a person's *quality* of performance of personal or instrumental activities of daily living. For more information about the AMPS please go to The Center for Innovative OT Solutions website.

Training: To use the AMPS you must 1) attend a full 5-day AMPS training course, 2) test 10 additional people within 3 months of the training course.

Course materials: When you register for the AMPS course you will receive:

- The five-day training course (approximately 8:00am to 5:30pm each day)
- The current AMPS manuals,
- A personal copy of the AMPS computer scoring software.
