


Welcome to Dalhousie Libraries!

Getting started:

Make sure you have a Dalhousie NetID. Your NetID and password are key to you accessing the many electronic resources available through Dalhousie. To acquire a Dalhousie NetID, you will need to receive approval as an adjunct by the school. Once you receive approval, your Dal identification # (aka banner number or boo number) will arrive by email. After you receive email notice of your banner number do the following to activate and/or look up your NetID:

- 1. Go to the Dal website (www.dal.ca)
- 2. Click on MyDal (top of the Home Page)



3. Click on New User?

4. Click on "Activate or Look up my NetID". Using this link allows you to look up your NetID, activated it, and then created a password. Follow the instructions carefully when creating your password or it will be refused. Type your birthdate exactly as illustrated on the page.
