

## STUDENTS WHOSE NATIVE LANGUAGE IS NOT ENGLISH

### General Information

The School acknowledges the importance of training professionals who are able to provide services in many languages. However, instruction is delivered in English, and therefore, the Faculty of Graduate Studies require all applicants whose native language is not English to demonstrate proficiency in English prior to being admitted to our programme. Applicants who are Canadian citizens or who have completed a degree at an institution where the language of instruction was English do not have to provide proof of English language proficiency.

The minimum scores for several English language proficiency tests are given below:

- **Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)**

Computer version .....	<b>237</b>
Internet version .....	<b>92</b>
Paper version .....	<b>580</b>
  
- **Michigan English Language Assessment Battery (MELAB) .....** **90**
  
- **International English Language Testing System (IELTS) .....** **7**
  
- **Canadian Test of English for Scholars and Trainees (CanTEST) - with no band score lower than 4.0 .....** **4.5 (average)**
  
- **Canadian Academic English Language Assessment (CAEL) - with no band score lower than 50 .....** **60 (overall)**

It is also recommended that applicants who take the paper version TOEFL test should also take the Test of Written English (TWE) component.
