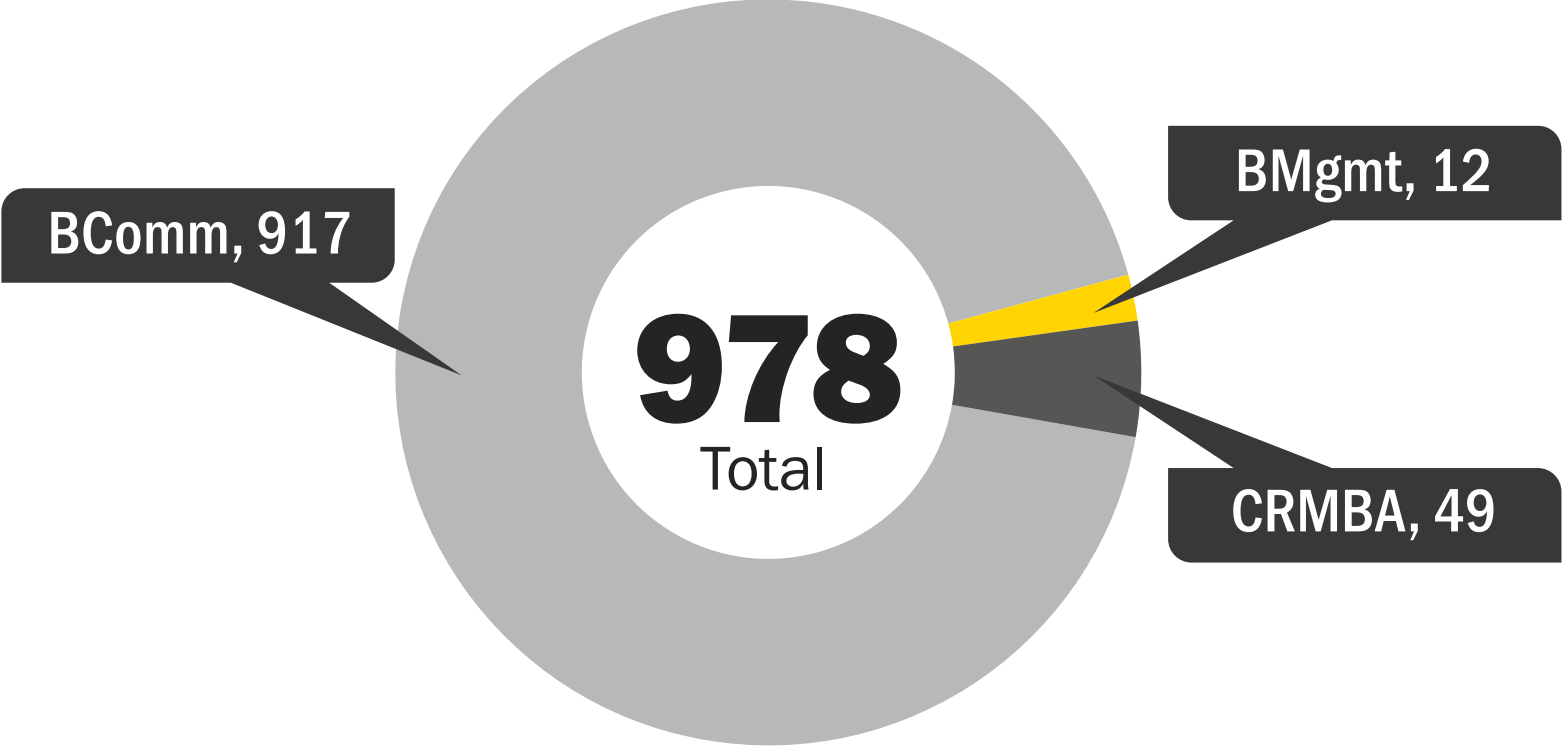

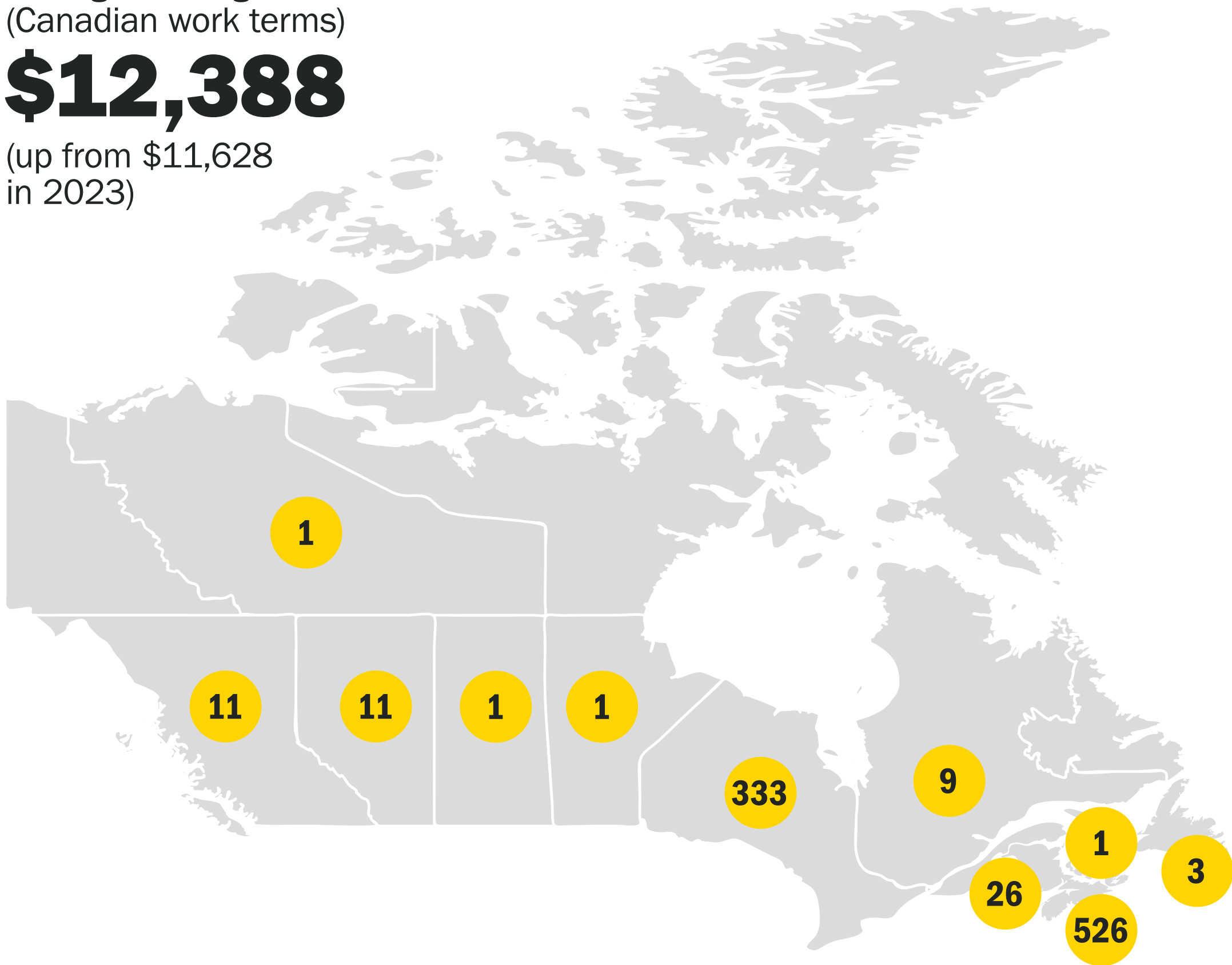
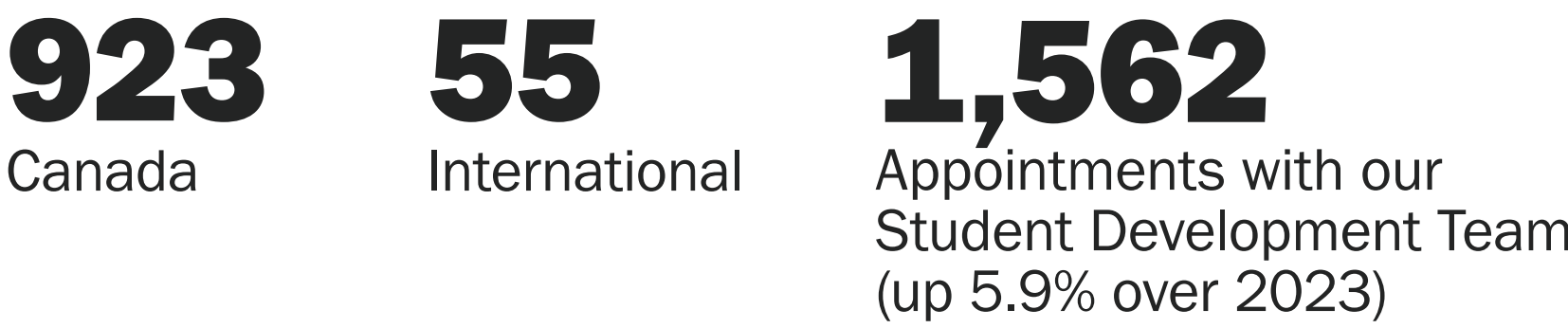

20,000 BUSINESS WORK TERMS

This fall, MCS reached an exciting milestone of 20,000 business work terms completed by our students in the Bachelor of Commerce Co-op, Bachelor of Management, and Corporate Residency MBA programs! Dalhousie proudly leads Atlantic Canada in work-integrated learning, with over 2,800 paid work terms completed in 2023-24 across five faculties and one college. In Atlantic Canada, no one knows work-integrated learning like Dalhousie. And at Dalhousie, no one knows work-integrated learning like the Faculty of Management, with almost 1,000 paid work terms in 2024, more than any other Faculty.

To celebrate this milestone, we have created a series of written and video profiles showcasing the journeys of some of our alumni over the years. We also hosted a special event at the Management Career Services office, bringing together MCS team members, our Faculty of Management Dean, Mike Smit (he/him), Faculty of Management staff, and student society leaders.
