





In spring 2025, MCS wrapped up its year-long celebration of reaching a major milestone: 20,000 business work terms completed by students in the Bachelor of Commerce Co-op, Bachelor of Management, and Corporate Residency MBA programs. Dalhousie proudly leads Atlantic Canada in work-integrated learning, with over 2,700 paid work terms completed in 2024-25 across five faculties and one college.
