Dalhousie Management Career Services (MCS) has been closely monitoring the Covid-19 situation. Today, I can offer all Summer 2020 Work Term students two options for the continuation of their degree.

Option 1: Proceed with a Summer 2020 Work Term

If you have already secured a position and would like to proceed, you can. If you have yet to obtain a work term, and you want to continue searching, you can.

Option 2: Online course replacement for the Summer 2020 Work Term

Further details concerning a new online Summer 2020 course are currently being developed by the Rowe School of Business and will be made available to students as soon as they are finalized. Please note that **no other course** is eligible to replace the work term.

Students are to take no action concerning dropping their work term course at this time. MCS and the Undergraduate Advising Office are working to coordinate the process to allow students to make their choice of the two options above and further details will be communicated as soon as possible.

All students who have yet to secure but wish to pursue a work term are **strongly recommended** to engage with their assigned Career and Recruitment (CRS) as soon as possible to discuss their work term job search strategy.

If you have already accepted a work term, it is essential to stay in contact with your supervisor or recruiter. The minimum requirement for the Summer 2020 Work Term is 12 weeks regardless of how many weeks your previous work terms were.
