

Management Career Services – COVID-19 Update #3 to Management Internship Summer 2020 Students

Good day,

The safety and well-being of our students is important to Management Career Services. In response to the current impacts of Covid-19, yesterday we announced changes to the Bachelor of Commerce Summer 2020 Work Term and want you to know that we are also concerned for our Bachelor of Management Internship Students. MCS is looking into a potential modification to ensure you are able to complete the optional internship component of your program.

Until we determine what that modification will be, these three options remain:

1. Continue to search for an internship to begin in May 2020.
 - Internships can begin as late as May 25, working until January 1
2. Defer your internship until September 2020.
 - Your graduation date would be impacted; however, you would gain eight months of industry experience making you more competitive in the job market post-graduation
3. Drop the internship and return to classes in September 2020.

As mentioned above, more information regarding a potential modification will become available in the coming weeks.
